

# 7. Melusina Cup

Which will be held on the

## Cents (Luxembourg).

## 1. Host and organizer

Host and organizer of the tournament is UWR Luxembourg, member of the Swimming Luxembourg and FLASSA.



#### 2. Venue and time:

The tournament will be in the indoor swimming pool in Cents on the weekend of the  $5^{th}$  and  $6^{th}$  October 2024. The pool dimensions are W=8m L= 15m D=3.8m.

Expected start on Saturday: 10:00 (Entry possible after 9:00)

Expected end on Sunday: 14:00

The award ceremony will take place after the final on Sunday in the entrance of the swimming pool.

## 3. Terms of participation

The Melusina Cup is supposed to be a leisure tournament.

All players must be able to present a valid license as well as a sports medical examination (not older than 1 year). These must be presented during the introductory meeting. In addition, underage players need signed parental consent to be permitted to participate.

#### 4. Rules

The games will be played according to the current international CMAS regulations. The tournament director will be defined on the day of the tournament. Any deviation from the rules (game, penalty, and time-out duration) will be announced during the team meeting before the beginning of the tournament and will be determined by the game mode and number of teams. Participation is in general not allowed. Any exception must be decided by the tournament committee.

#### 5. Game mode

The game mode will be determined by the number of registered teams. The tournament schedule will be made available on the tournament homepage and per email a few days before the tournament.

#### 6. Referees

All teams should provide at least two referees. The compensation fee will be 30€ per referee. Scuba tanks, regulators and weight belts will be provided by the organizers. Referees will need to bring their own wetsuits and BCDs.

## 7. Catering

Since it is a school swimming pool, there is no bistro/restaurant. You are allowed to bring your own food, but it must not be consumed in the swimming pool area or the changing rooms.

Attention: There is an absolute ban on glass in the changing rooms and throughout the entire swimming pool area.

#### 8. Protests

Protests must be submitted in written form to the tournament committee within 30 minutes after the game's end. The protest fee will be 50€ and will be refunded if the protest is successful.

#### 9. Disclaimer

Participation at the tournament will be at the participant's own risk. UWR Luxembourg cannot be held responsible for any loss or injury. Instructions from the swimming pool personnel and the Organizers must be respected.

## 10. Acceptance, Recognition Policy

By registering for the tournament, the clubs and their players accept all points of this invitation.

#### 11. Accommodation

Only 2.5 km away from the swimming pool, there is a youth hostel where "UWR Luxembourg" has pre-reserved a certain number of beds. You can stay here for €34 per night. Reservations are made exclusively through "UWR Luxembourg." Please do not send reservations directly to the youth hostel. The number of pre-reserved beds is limited, and we operate on a "first come, first serve" basis.

#### 14. Single players

Players who would like to participate in the tournament but do not have their own team are welcome to sign up in advance. Every registered player will be assigned to a team!

### 15. Registration

To simplify the organization of the tournament, accommodation and meals, each registered team will receive an online Excel file to enter all data.
